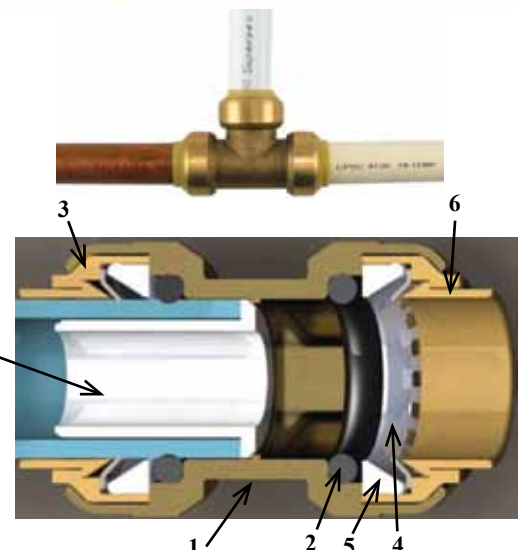

Application: For capping 8" domestic or industrial wells to ensure vermin proof/watertight sealing to the well casing. The 8" cap fits both steel or PVC well casings with an 8-5/8" outside diameter.

Features:

- Absolutely the EASIEST & FASTEST heavy duty well cap to install, easy to access well for maintenance.
- Casing stop is built into the lower ring assembly, therefore the top cover does not have to be attached to the lower ring to find the proper location on the casing, and this greatly reduces the weight / awkwardness when affixing the lower compression ring assembly to the well casing.
- The well cap has a deep socket to ensure that the gaskets seals down from the top edge of the well casing. This compensates for well casings that have not been cut off straight to ensure the cap will seal 100% on every installation.
- The top cover of the cap can easily be removed without disturbing the seal to the well casing, or interfering with the wiring or conduit.
- Top cover is sealed to the lower assembly by compressing a soft, thick durable SBR gasket that will stand the test of time and last through repeated removal and replacement of the top cover for servicing the well. It is held in perfect position by the middle ring casting making installation a breeze.
- Large 2" FPT conduit connection.
- Caps are supplied with a ground bolt and two ring terminal connectors. The middle ring has three S.S. grounding set screws to bond the well cap to the well casing (steel).
- Locking feature provides a secure / tamper proof design. Simply insert a padlock thru the S.S. locking pin.
- Large 2" mushroom vent cap with SS screen is provided as standard equipment to ensure the cap is Vermin Proof.
- Replacement of the vent with a standard 2" MPT thread plug quickly converts this vented well cap into a truly watertight cap where and when required.
- Caps are supplied with a grounding screw and two ring terminals as standard equipment.
- Personalization is available by means of an engraved aluminum plate.
- Individually boxed, with a gross shipping weight of 32.04 lbs, the well cap has a net weight of 30.73 lbs.

- High quality grey cast iron castings
- All hardware is Stainless Steel for maximum corrosion resistance (No Plated Fasteners).
- Thick soft SBR rubber gasket with dual taper to ensure a positive watertight compression seal to the well casing.
- Top cover is sealed to the lower assembly by a thick durable SBR gasket, which is formed to fit the casting to maintain proper position and alignment.
- Durable blue powder coat paint, which is baked to ensure superior quality finish.
